HEAD AND NECK CANCERS: ROAD TO REHABILITATION

BCIP organized its annual E-conference BCIPCON on the theme Head and Neck Cancers: Road to Rehabilitation on 29th and 30th April'23. Head and Neck cancers include group of cancers of the mouth, sinuses, nose, or throat and ranks the 2nd most common type of Cancers. The estimated number of incident cases of cancer in India for the year 2022 was found to be 14,61,427. In India, one in nine people are likely to develop cancer in his/her lifetime. According to the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) the disease may jump by 12.8 percent from 2020 to 2025. This makes this a topic to be addressed with much more seriousness and fervor. Head and neck cancer statistics have risen in past decade. Realising the seriousness of the topic and demand of the hour, this topic was taken up as the point of discussion in this year's conference. Speakers were approached from all over the globe who practice and have expertise in Head and Neck cancer cases. Scientific committee sessions were kept promoting research and updating of clinical practice. Paper presentation of junior and senior category was kept on 28th April'23. Entries from students (undergraduate and post-graduate), PhD scholars and academicians were divided into Junior and Senior category.

The conference got accreditation the form of 7 credit hours from Delhi Council of Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy. The conference proceedings will be published with ISBN number.
